The Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes an occupational health nurse's outstanding contribution locally and provincially to the Occupational Health Nursing specialty and to the professional organization (OOHNA).

Throughout her career, and in her current position as Vice President of the Public Services Health and Safety Association (PSHSA), Henrietta (Henri) continually advocates for the health care sector in Ontario and for Occupational Health Nurses as a whole. Throughout her years of service Henri's work has gained repeated respect and recognition from provincial, national, and international peers and colleagues. One of her achievements is being the Co-founder of the National Alliance for Safety and Health in Healthcare (NASHH) in which the majority of provinces in Canada are actively involved.

As an educator, Henri has been a key instructor at Mohawk College for the National Institute of Disability Management and Research (NIDMAR) programs in Disability Management, and a guest lecturer at the Dalla Lana School of Public Health at the University of Toronto. She continues to both share her academic and professional expertise and mentor many OHN's and other health care professionals.
